Here is the letter giving you information for the term ahead.

Along with this letter you will find an overview of this term's learning. It would be most helpful if you could share this information with your child.

In our Wider Curriculum learning this term we will explore the following:

Year 1: In History, we will explore toys from the past and present and how they have changed over time. Later in the term, in Geography, we will be learning all about our local area of Tewkesbury and where our school is located.

Year 2: In History, we will be the exploring the events of the Great Fire of London, what London was like before the fire, how the fire started and why it spread so easily. Later in Geography, we will be looking at London as our capital city and make comparisons with our local area of Tewkesbury.

P.E

Outdoor Learning
