Dear Parents and carers,

Happy New Year! We hope you all had a great Christmas and are now ready for a fantastic 2026 in school. Thank you all for your very kind Christmas wishes and lovely gifts.

Along with this letter you will find an overview of this term's learning. It would be most helpful if you could share this information with your child.

Year 1: We will be continuing our Geography learning from last term which focuses on Our Local Area. Later in the term we will move back to History and explore Homes Throughout Time.

Year 2: In History this term, we will be exploring transport through the ages, exploring the different types of transport that has been invented over the years. Later in term our topic focus will be Geography. We will be understanding geographical similarities and differences of two contrasting places.

P.E.

Please ensure that PE kits are brought into school on a Monday for the week ahead. They will then be returned on a Friday. The P.E. kit should include a t-shirt, a pair of correctly fitting footwear and shorts. In colder months, children may wish to wear jogging bottoms.

Outdoor Learning

Y1: Please ensure that puddle suits, wellies and the kit listed by Miss Hunt is in school for Outdoor Learning sessions. This will be returned to you at the end of every term so it can be cleaned.

Y2: Outdoor learning sessions will take place later in the year. We will be in touch with further details about this nearer the time.

Home Spellings

Every Monday, we will send out the Year 1 and 2 spelling activities for the week so that children can practise these at home. Y2 will have a spelling quiz each Friday based on the spellings sent home that week.

Reading Diaries

We would like to see Reading Diaries completed so that we can support you and your child with their home reading journey. Please could these be sent into school each day

along with their chosen reading book, this will allow them to be changed swiftly once children need a new one.

Library visits

We will visit the library regularly to explore the books on offer and make selections. Please bring library books back to school once finished so that they can be changed on our visits.

Homework

Children in Year 1 and 2 will be expected to do the following for homework each week:

- Reading – children to read at least four times across a seven-day week.
- Doodle Maths – children to complete the Doodle Maths assignment which is set each Monday (when they login to Doodle, the assignment can be found by clicking 'assignments'). This assignment always links to their current learning in maths.
- Spelling activities sent home each week practice of words sent home.
